Background: HERCA

- Since 2012 HERCA TF E&T
 - General picture: less harmonization on E&T in RP
- In 2013 HERCA recommended further guidance1:
 - on duties and practical competences RPE
 - on the role of RPO and training and competencies
 - HERCA BoH acknowledges importance E&T in RP and mutual recognition of RPE/RPO, but pointed out that first priority should be to update national systems to the new BSS Directive

Background: HERCA (2)

 In 2014 HERCA TF E&T was tasked with development of criteria/guidelines for the implementation of RPE and RPO (making use of ENETRAP I, II, III results where appropriate) and respecting diversity in implementation of the BSS in the framework of the HERCA Action Plan on the role of HERCA in the transposition of Euratom-BSS.

Workpackages

- WP1 Project coordination
- WP2 Organisation of "think-tank" activities and establishment of partnerships ensuring feedback from stakeholders
- <u>WP3</u> Establishment of three specialized training modules for RPE and implementation of pilot sessions
