Venue and accommodation

Local host

The workshop is hosted by STUK – Radiation and Nuclear Safety Authority and will take place at their headquarters in Jokiniemi, a district of the town of Vantaa, Finland.

The closest train and bus station is in **Vantaa Tikkurila**, which is close to Jokiniemi, 800 metres from STUK.

How to reach STUK from Helsinki airport

Helsinki Airport's train station is located under the terminal. There is a direct elevator and escalator connection from the departures and arrivals hall to the train station.

Local I and P trains operate to and from Helsinki Airport. To reach Tikkurila you should take the P-train. A train ride with P train from the airport to Vantaa Tikkurila takes about 25 minutes and to Helsinki City Centre about 45 minutes. Local train tickets can be purchased from HSL's mobile app, or from the ticket machine at the train platform. Timetables, tickes and fares for local trains and can be found on HSL.fi.

How to reach STUK from Helsinki city centre

You can take several trains from Helsinki Central station. The commuter trains K, I, P, R and Z and all long-distance trains stop at the Tikkurila station.

Accomodation

It is recommended that participants stay in Vantaa. For example, <u>Original Sokos Hotel Vantaa</u> is about 15 minutes' walk from STUK and about 5 minutes' walk from Tikkurila railway station.

Participants can also look for hotels in Helsinki City Centre or there are several airport hotels.
